


Step 1: Our first step was to hold meetings.



Well Water Electricity Six Weeks Irrigation

Why Gopher Wire?

- Gopher wire can last up to ten years.
- Our Student Advisor verified this by calling several Parks and Recreation Offices that successfully used this strategy.
- It costs \$24,000 for double galvanized steel gopher wire.
- Without gopher wire, the gophers will quickly return.



Step 4: Move forward.



*Our goal was to inspire others to help our cause and bring our community together.

*Our collective fundraising goal was \$1,500. We've raised \$2,000 through snack bars and dances.

*We created a fundraising letter approved by Mr. Harris on February 5.




In Conclusion, here are potential benefits of this project
