I, the undersigned, state, on information and belief, that defendant did, in Del Norte Judicial District, County of Del Norte, State of California, commit the following crimes:

COUNT 1.

PERJURY BY DECLARATION in violation of Penal Code section 118(a), a felony.

On or about February 8, 2022, the defendant did unlawfully, under penalty of perjury, declare as true that which was known to be false, to wit: the defendant listed his address as 16855 US Highway 101 N #2, Smith River, California, 95531 on his California Voter Registration form.

COUNT 2.

FALSE VOTER REGISTRATION in violation of Elections Code section 18100(a), a felony.


On or about February 8, 2022, the defendant did unlawfully register to vote in Del Norte County, knowing that he is not entitled to registration.

COUNT 3.

FALSE DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY in violation of Elections Code section 18203, a felony.

On or about February 14, 2022, the defendant did unlawfully file or submit for filing a nomination paper or declaration of candidacy knowing that any part of it was made falsely, to wit: the defendant stated he meets the statutory and residency requirements to run for the office of Sheriff of Del Norte County.
