
2022 Howland Hill Rd Statistics

• 2022 Howland Hill Rd generated many calls for service resulting in LE reports documenting a variety of crimes and incidents.


• Howland Hill Rd had 8 recorded motor vehicle accident reports taken by LE Staff in 2022.

• Multiple visitor reports were made to park staff regarding traffic accidents and vehicles off the roadway that self-rescued prior to LE response.

Rising Visitation within RNP & Howland Hill















Emergency procedures

- Emergency vehicles (Police, Fire, Ambulance) while responding to emergencies with lights and sirens can drive both directions
- Howland Hill Road will be returned to two-way traffic during emergency situations identified by the park or other emergency services agencies (major fire/evacuations etc.)
- CHP, DNSO, Crescent City PD, CalFire, Crescent Fire
