DNHS Proposal for Reopening the 2020-21 School Year (August 3, 2020)

More than anything, Del Norte High wants to teach our students and go back to normal school as soon as possible. We are struggling with the sheer number of students that enter our building, approximately 1000, and each of those students have six or seven different classes. When we consider reopening for the 2020-21 school year, we would like to propose a hybrid: Everyday, M-F, DNHS students will engage with their teachers virtually from 9 AM to 12:00 PM. Instruction, collaboration, checking for understanding, attendance, and assessment will happen during this time. Students will then be able to participate in Tier 2 interventions, small cohorts or teacher office hours from 1:00-3:15 either virtually or in person.
